7/2/2024 SANDOWN LAKESIDE

Race 1 – 3:10PM WELCOME TO SPORTSBET SANDOWN MAIDEN (1300M)

Rail out 3m the entire circuit today and expecting the Lakeside track to play fairly, with a lean-to finding runners settling close to the speed as a starting point.

We have a lot of time for #2 JAMMIN JIMMY. We've been really taken by the style in which this horse moves in his work leading into his debut run. He stepped a tad slow at his first jump out but love the way he found the line under no riding there late. His 2nd jump out at Bendigo was super impressive. Jumped much cleaner there and once he got to the middle of the track upon straightening, he lengthened like a good horse. Love the way he moves and think 1300m on debut is perfect. He may take his medicine and go back from barrier 8 but trusting John Allen gives him every opportunity here and the Mitch Freedman stable are flying of late.

All the money today has come for #6 CASTLE ON HIGH. He is an NZ import having his first start for the Anthony & Sam Freedman camp. His most recent trial over 1200m at Mornington was good and he is certainly a stylish mover as well. Looks to have his share of talent and fronts up here for his first run as a gelding. Zahra to ride here and barrier 5 are both positives and he can win.

SELECTION:

#2 JAMMIN JIMMY (win).

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Race 3 – 4:20PM FIERCE IMPACT QUALITY YEARLINGS' MAIDEN (1200M)

Field of 11 to contest this event and 10 of them are on debut. As such, it is a tricky race to be able to build an accurate speed map, but think BOLLON, KING BLING, LAST DRUID, RUBIQUITY and FLYER will all be keen to be near the speed.

Very tough race, but we thought #13 WESTERN CONQUEROR looked to be over the odds here. The two jump outs this time in have been quite good, and certainly no worse than many others in the market here. Liked his last jump out over 800m at Cranbourne on 15/1 where was finished 2nd behind Hayasugi, who subsequently came out and was an impressive winner of the fillies Blue Diamond Preview. We thought he moved quite nicely there and were quite surprised to see him come up \$19/\$4.60 in this field. It is an incredibly open and even race with many winning chances but must be with him on a small each way basis given the price he has come up here.

Of the others, #4 BOLLON was an impressive jump out winner and draws very well here. Should put himself on speed and be very hard to beat. #13 RUBIQUITY as shown speed in two jump outs this time in, winning the latest by a space. Looks a nice horse. #1 ATHANATOS won a jump out very well on 9/1 but was a little plain at his next. If he runs up to his first jump out, he is a chance at odds also.

SELECTION:

#13 WESTERN CONQUEROR (small each way).

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7/2/2024 WARWICK FARM

Race 1 – 1:50PM RACING AND SPORTS MAIDEN (1300M)

Racing on a Soft 7 currently with the rail out 5m. OKAMI STAR should lead them up here. Imagine BOSUSTOW settles closer up 200m in trip and from the inside gate. LINEBACKER will look to press forward from gate 5 also. Speed looks moderate on paper.

#1 BOSUSTOW and #6 TATAGLIA both come through the same race at Rosehill on 20/1. BOSUSTOW got a long way back on that occasion, but like the way he hit the line and suggest the 1300m here at his second start will be to his liking. Draws 1 today and can be much closer in the running and looks a good winning chance. TARTAGLIA was in front of Bosustow on debut but suggest he will find himself behind him in the run today from barrier 7. Like the way he hit the line to run 3rd there and no reason why 1300m won't suit him as well. Looks a horse with it's share of talent and can't ignore his winning chances in this event either.

We have had #4 LINEBACKER in the black book since his 2nd trial at Randwick on 22/1. He flew the gates from the outside barrier and settled outside the leader. He travelled strongly in to the straight before taking over inside the last 100m to record a lovely win. The 3rd horse from that trial, Getafix, came out and won last week impressively on debut and Enriched (5th) has come out since that trial and pushed Shangri La Express, who is right in the market for the Slipper. Think there were some nice horses in that heat and to our eye he was the best mover. The Soft 7 is an unknown but we want to be with him here on debut as we believe he will be the best horse to come out of this race.

Having a very, very small bet on #7 SENSITIVE SOUL here also. Didn't mind her trial before her debut run over 900m where she was run off her legs but loved the way she attacked the line. Massive step up in class here, but the 1300m will suit and we can't let her go around at \$151 with something very small on.

SELECTION:

#4 LINEBACKER (win), #7 SENSITIVE SOUL (very small win).

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
