12/6/2024 BALLARAT

Race 8 – 4:30PM HYGAIN WINNERS CHOICE 0-64 (1100 METRES)

Track is a Soft 7 with the rail out 8m the circuit and from the races run so far, the track appears even.

#7 PHARARI has come up the short priced favourite and that is no surprise given the dominance of her maiden win at Cranbourne on 10/5. She was slightly slow to step but mustered through to lead and upon straightening put a big space on her rivals to win by 8 lengths. The race rated well, and that win was off the back of some smart trials. She has had a quiet jump out leading into this and looks the deserved favourite albeit a shade under the odds.

We were with #13 STOKKE last time out in a tough BM64 at Sandown and thought she acquitted herself well. She was caught wide early and faced the breeze and battled on well to be beaten 1 length. She has been back to the jump outs since, and we thought she put in an exceptional piece of work. She jumped to the front and moved clear under a hold before the jockey asked her to sprint and she accelerated very sharply. She went on to win by 10+ lengths and moved very well. Drawn barrier 4 for Linda Meech here she looks to get a good run in the race and at the current quote of \$6 we want to have something on.

#8 QUISEEN is another with a winning chance off the back of a good maiden win at this track on 26/5. She worked her way through the small field on that occasion to win in soft fashion, with Declan Bates not required to produce the whip at any stage. She may give the other leading chances a bit of a head start here, however. #10 WRITTEN BLIGH ran well in running 2nd through the same race as STOKKE and must be a chance also.
