Race 1 - 12:50PM HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

Wet track here at Canterbury and we kick off with a Maiden over 1200m. Speed from WRITEGO with MISS JONES handy.

#5 BURMA STAR makes his debut for Chris Waller and comes into this on the back of a very nice trial at Rosehill over 900m. James McDonald takes the ride which is a positive and the pair draw to find the right part of the track potentially. This colt extended nicely in his most recent trial and looks to be in very good order. He is by Exceed and Excel and should get through the wet no issues, noting his best run came on the Soft 6. Horse to beat and looks a bet.

#12 TYREEK trialled up okay and could find the right part of the track from barrier 1. He has a solid grounding for this race coming off a 1045m trial win at Randwick. #6 MISS JONES is here at peak fitness. She brings some nice ratings into this and will be competitive. #13 SPICE PRAWN is the other main danger. This filly was very good first-up, hitting the line sharply, running the fastest final 600 and 200m of the race. The race did not rate overly well and she does look short enough.
