## Race 6 - 3:30PM INGLIS GOLDEN GIFT (1100 METRES)

NORTH ENGLAND to lead from 3, with GAEILGE working over and adding some pressure, potentially taking over. CHICAMA is a Waterhouse runner, and won't be far away. O'OLE also has speed. RNSW map has her going back to last but can't see that happening when there may be a chance she can slot in from 6 and find a nice run with a couple with similar speed are drawn wide.

We were keen on #2 NORTH ENGLAND on debut and we're sticking with him. The \$280,000 Inglis Classic purchase by champion 2YO Farnan lost no admirers on debut, setting a genuine tempo out in front and sticking on to just be run down very late. He wasn't the fastest away and struck a bit of interference on jumping, so he was used up early and stuck on incredibly well. He looked the winner, leading until the 10m mark. Up in distance (to 1100m) is no issue for this stable and is often a positive. Rosehill will likely also suit. 5 weeks between runs but a brilliant trial at Hawkesbury, covering ground and proving too strong late. Love the fact they have travelled him to trial and was very good in that piece of work. Clark stays, fitter, perfect barrier and the horse to beat.

#9 TUPAKARA fits a similar bill, running on the same day, 5 weeks between runs and a winning trial since. Her trial was fantastic leading in, beating 3 rivals comfortably. Thought she was only good on debut and that run didn't scream back me next start at under \$5 in a strong race against the boys but she does get some favours here. Barrier 1 could be beneficial but she will need to jump well (which she did in her trial). And she trialed nicely. Could be 3 back the fence which would not be ideal for her but she was well backed on debut and has ability.

#7 ICARIAN DREAN looks short enough off a Warwick Farm win where they walked. #5 WEST OF SWINDON looks the pick of the debutants. Showed speed on debut, kicking up and holding out his rivals to lead at a moderate tempo. He kicked strongly and was strong through the line.

## Race 2 – 1:15PM INGLIS BANNER LISTED 2YO (1000 METRES)

We found the winner of the 2YO race on Cup Day at a nice price and aiming to replicate that here. Field of 11, 3 have raced and 8 on debut. We saw Oaks Day that the outside lanes became the place to be for the straight races and predicting the same here.

#8 CHISHOLM comes up favourite. The first trial on 4/10 at Rosehill was okay at best but liked her 2nd effort on 15/10 at Warwick Farm where she showed speed and kicked clear to win stylishly. Slight query is that 2nd effort was on a Heavy 8 and she is back on to a dry track for this. She's a regally bred and nice filly and can win but we feel she's a shade short at the current quote.

We have liked both jump outs from #10 ROHESIA. Particularly liked the way she lowered and extended when asked for an effort at her most recent hit out on 1/11. She's a lovely mover, draws the right part of the track and the Hayes boys are flying with their 2-year-olds. Looks a good each way play at the current quote of \$8.50. One of the first runners for sire Hanseatic which is a point of interest also.

#11 WITHIN THE LAW comes down from Sydney and trialled well behind North England (tipped above) at its most recent trial. Drawn 11 it can certainly win.

#3 LATIN BOSS is a professional type and has impressed at both hit outs, while #5 BUBION ran well on debut albeit with the race shape to suit.

Watch on #4 RED BARRON. We mentioned in the preview for Tuesday's Maribyrnong Plate that the trial was better than its price and he backs up here with the blinkers on in what looks a clear plan from the Corstens team. His work late wasn't bad Tuesday, and he looks to have some level of ability, but this is certainly a bold strategy. Watch any mate market support.

## Race 9 - 5:50PM World Horse Racing Grand Handicap (1100 METRES)

Think they will be coming down the outside in these straight races. We saw that on Oaks Day with the inside clearly inferior going. Wonder if some jockeys have picked up on that by now? JMac knew early, producing a brilliant winning ride from gate 1 on Thursday.

Speed from SHESALLSHENANIGANS, RIVKIN and TRAPEZE WARRIOR with plenty of others in behind having speed. Fast tempo expected.

With #1 KEENAN on an each way basis but don't want to lose if #10 PISANELLO or #12 KIKO wins. They're the three we're playing. #1 KEENAN was beaten 1.49L in a Listed Fireball at Randwick when we last saw him. That's a good form reference for a race like this. Two Flemington Jump-outs, the latest was very impressive, moving well, running second under little pressure. Returns here Gelded and clearly has the class.

We backed #10 PISANELLO last start when first-up, on the back of trialling like an absolute star. The money came for him and he destroyed his rivals, running a career peak figure. If he replicates that he'll be highly competitive and there's a chance he can improve again second up, up to 1100m. Barrier 1 a big query but has the master McDonald sticking with him. Even luck, he can definitely win.

#12 KIKO is another that goes in. Freshened and looks suitable. Flies straight. Sliced through in a recent jump-out win, looking very impressive, beating Manolo Bling who won on Tuesday. Good fresh horse.

#9 NAVAL ACADEMY probably goes into multiples. #11 DUAL PRESSURE ran Isthmus to 0.75 two back. Was a huge price there. Always scared of Adelaide form in the Flemington Carnival (think Derby), and #6 RIVKIN was good last start at Morphettville.

### SELECTION:

#5 KEENAN (EW)

Backing #10 PISANELLO so we don't lose on the race and #12 KIKO can win and goes in everything.

## Race 2 – 1:27PM SKYCITY OPEN HANDICAP (1250 METRES)

Track will be in the Good 4 range for this meeting with the rail out 9m from the 1000m to the winning post. The assumption would be that rail out this far on a tight turning track like the Parks circuit would be an up and in bias but generally you can make ground with this set up and tempo is more important.

We loved the recent trial from #1 RUBAMOS at Balaklava on 31/10. He levelled up to the horse inside him at the 200 under no riding and when slipped a bit of rein, he ran away from the field impressively. He was aimed up at the better sprinting races during the SA carnival in his first prep for the Bain & Taylor stable and wasn't disgraced, finishing within 4L of horses like Climbing Star and Benedetta. The stable have had more time to work him out now and we think he is going extremely well based on his trial this time in. Looks a great each way bet at \$11.

Very even race outside of him. #4 JACKS ON ICE could get an easy lead and if he does, he will be very hard to beat. Recent for has been consistent and he always runs well at this level around this circuit. #5 DELIGHTFUL SHECKY returned well first up after going to a new level at the back end of last prep. Goes well at the Parks track, just looks a little short. #6 WIGGUM hit the line well last time out and sets up to get a similar run just off the speed here and is a good horse on his day. Chances don't end there, very even and open affair.
