Rail out 3m after True last meeting here last Thursday where the fence was clearly inferior. Suggest they will again be coming down the middle of the track, getting away from the inside again, particularly later in the meeting.

Race 2 - 6:15PM Shanks Electrical BM64 Handicap (Chute) (1000 METRES)

Three scratchings and a small field but there is a little bit of natural speed engaged. EPIC CENTRE has 1000m speed and with a big weight they may go forward and take up the running. PERIDOT STAR also has speed.

#6 DAELLA was put away after a nice win last time and went to the paddock full of confidence. She looks to have improved and come back a better, more furnished horse. Loved her recent jump-out win at Caulfield Heath, working home well down the outside. If you watch that jump-out, she was called incorrectly, getting confused with the stablemate in the same colours. DAELLA was the horse down the outside, in what was a brilliant piece of work. She has a nice sprint on her and looks the horse to beat first-up today. DAELLA comes into barrier 1 after scratchings. Ideally, she won't be leading here, getting a nice cart into the race behind the speed in the small field. Would like Brown to keep away from the fence ideally.

#5 PERIDOT STAR has tactical speed and has won her last two. Wanted to see a bit more from her in a recent jump-out but she has upside, is trained on track and is a scary horse. Two wins on the synthetic is a negative and she hadn't had a run on top of the ground on turf.

#4 TUMBLING is 1 from 1 at the 1000m and 2 from 4 first-up. He is a nice horse and his last start performance produced a high rating. Tipping he is the main danger to #6 DAELLA.
